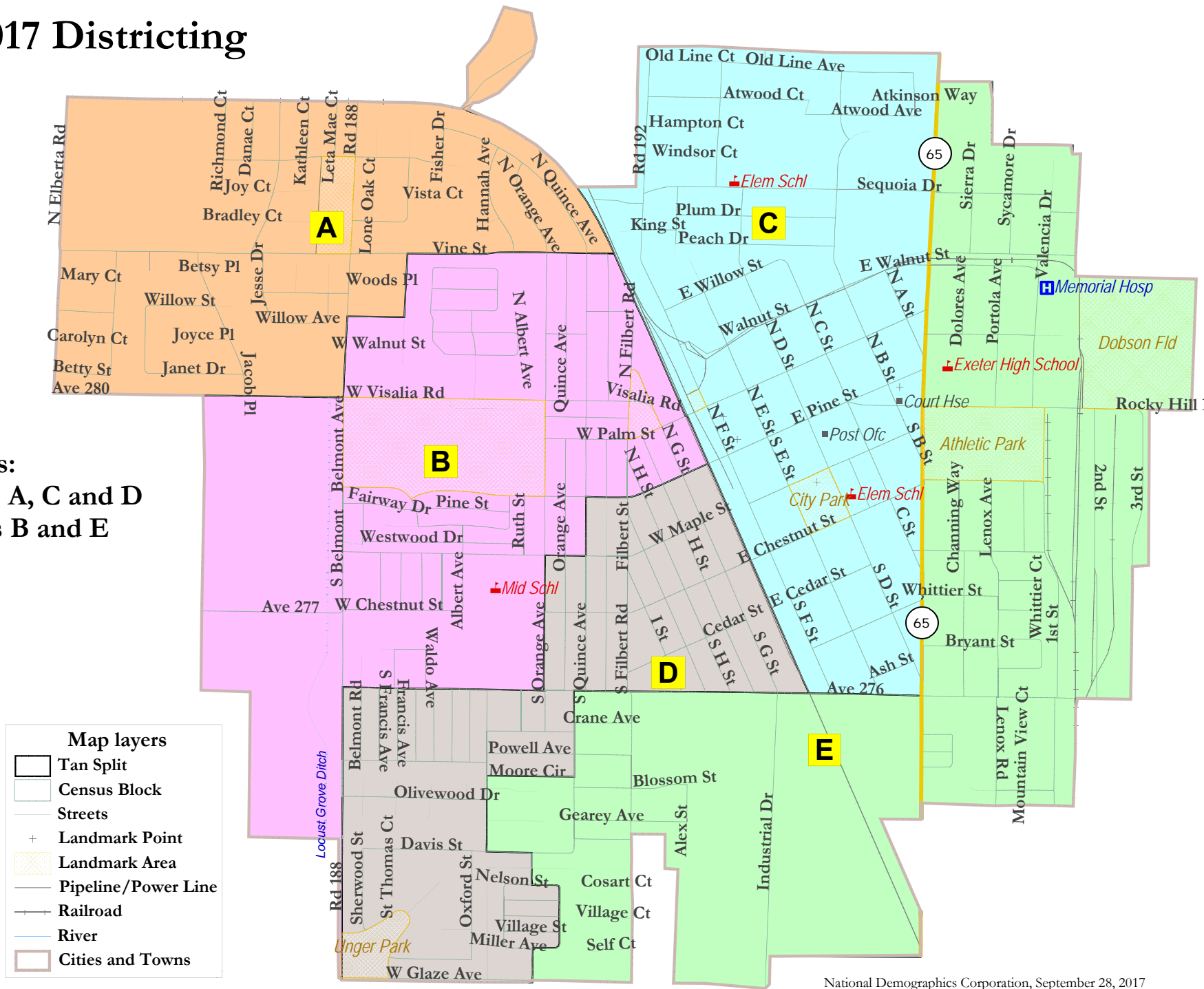


# Exeter 2017 Districting
